Some do's and don'ts for returning to classes

We will be eternally grateful to our venues for their vigilance during the pandemic, allowing us a safe return to face-to-face classes. Now that Government restrictions have been eased we can expect a little more freedom in what we do. However, we still want everyone to feel confident in their return to classes this term. The following mitigations therefore remain in place and we should be grateful if you would kindly observe these as much as you can. We also have some additional requests, in the interest of the safety and wellbeing of our students:

ALL VENUES:

Please respect any mitigations put in place which may not be listed here, and kindly acquiesce to any requests made by venue staff;

Face masks should be worn in all public areas - they are not required in the actual dance space;

Most venues will still have anti-bacterial gel available and you should sanitise hands when entering and leaving the premises;

Our teachers will still be cleaning touch points;

Students should be accompanied by only one person who should leave as soon as possible after seeing their child safely into the hall;

Students should arrive dressed ready for class but they **MUST** cover up, ie wear trousers and a jacket over their dancewear. It is inappropriate for them to be in the public domain in just leotards and tights;

Where the hall is not adjacent to the parking area parents are respectfully requested to accompany their child to, and collect them from, the door, especially once the nights are drawing in.

HALL-SPECIFIC REQUIREMENTS:

Beaulieu - Parents are requested not to enter the building (BWYB class excepted). The teacher will come to the foyer and collect the children and will return them to the foyer at the end of class. Please, therefore, be prompt for arrival and collection;

Chelmer Village - Once your child has gone into class please be so kind as to vacate the building, returning only in time for collection;

Springfield Parish Centre - Please be aware that CCTV operates within the Centre. It is therefore totally inappropriate for children to change in public areas. If children have to change between classes (ie between ballet and commercial jazz) this **MUST** be done in the studio. Similarly, should they need sustenance between classes (and this should only be a non-sticky drink and a biscuit or fruit) then this, too, has to be taken in the studio;

Widford Village Hall - As this hall is within a residential area, and only has a small car park, please be considerate when parking on the road and do not block residents' driveways.
